BigBloc Construction Ltd Reports Revenue from Operations of Rs. 224.6 crore in FY25



Ahmedabad, BigBloc Construction Limited, one of the largest manufacturers of Aerated Autoclaved Concrete (AAC) Blocks, Bricks, and Panels in India has reported consolidated net profit of Rs. 3.2 crore. Revenue from Operations during FY25 was reported at Rs. 224.6 crore and EBITDA of Rs. 29.2 crore. During Q4FY2025 company reported revenue of Rs. 64.6 crore, EBITDA of Rs. 5.7 crore. Promoter Group have further increased their stake to 72.67% as of March 2025, acquiring 60,000 shares from the open market in the March quarter. Incorporated in 2015, BigBloc Construction Ltd is one of the largest and only listed company in the AAC Block Space with an installed capacity of 1.3 million cubic meter per

annual capacity across plants in Gujarat (Kheda, Umargaon, Kapadvanj) and Maharashtra (Wada). BigBloc Constructions Ltd is among very few companies in AAC industry to generate carbon credits. Mr. Narayan Saboo, Chairman, BigBloc Construction Ltd said, "For the financial year 2025, BigBloc Construction reported consolidated Revenue from Operations of Rs. 2,246 Mn, a decline of 7.6% YoY. The decrease in revenue was primarily attributed to a slowdown in India's construction sector, a key demand driver for our products, which experienced a period of deceleration due to several external factors. The General elections in the country led to delays in government-led infrastructure projects, while prolonged monsoon conditions disrupted site operations, logistics, and supply chains. These factors collectively impacted order flows, site execution and on-ground activity, particularly in core geographies such as Maharashtra and Gujarat. (18-2)

Veraval became the AP center of the MGNREGA scam

Monday means a flurry of work in all the offices of Gandhinagar. Even officers from outside prefer to come to Gandhinagar for various work on Mondays. With such a thought, Sanjay Modi, Director of Gir Somnath District Village Development Agency, had come to Gandhinagar



when his phone rang at 11:16 am. As soon as I picked up the phone, the person on the other end said, "It's not good that you've stopped payment for my material. There will be murder." This sudden call had increased the officer's anxiety. The caller was Congress veteran Hira Jotwa. Sanjay Modi was investigating the alleged irregularities in the contract work of his agency Vrindavan Construction under the MGNREGA scheme, due to which his payment of more than Rs 4 crore was stopped. This was the beginning of a series of threats to Sanjay Modi. In 27 days, Hira Jotwa had threatened this officer directly and indirectly 4 times. Once, he even went to Sanjay Modi's office and said that if payment is not made, I have a sharpshooter ready. All these things are written in the police complaint filed by Sanjay Modi against Hira Jotwa in 2018. This police complaint is also mentioned in the affidavit he gave during the 2019 Lok Sabha elections. The wheel of time has turned in such a way that once

again the name of Hira Jotwa has started being discussed in the MNREGA scam. It has been revealed in the investigation of Divya Bhaskar that his own agencies in Gir Somnath district and those of people associated with him in Bharuch and Narmada districts have illegally approved bills worth crores of rupees for goods. Coincidentally, Sanjay Modi is currently the collector of Narmada district. The epicenter of MGNREGA agencies, a small village in Veraval, Hira Jotwa is a Congress leader who is not an MLA or MP. Despite not winning a major election, he is very close to the MLAs and MPs of not only the Congress but also the rival BJP. He is often seen on stage with people he considers 'self-made men' and Hira Jotwa gives examples of his relationship with them. In a village in Veraval, Khoba Jevada, he shows the addresses of some such agencies, which are super active in getting MGNREGA contracts in the tribal belt of South Gujarat, five hundred and fifty kilometers away. Understand how the owners of these agencies played the game of filling their pockets in the name of development. It will also become clear whether Hira Jotwa is involved in this to any extent or not. A few days ago, Divya Bhaskar had investigated the scam committed by the agencies of Minister Bachu Khabar's sons in Dahod district in MGNREGA and showed the dust flying. Later, both the sons of the minister were arrested, but Bachubhai's sons are minor players in this case.
